1. All nominees whose applications are shortlisted **must** be available during the judging period in April/May and August for telephone interviews. It is the responsibility of the nominee to make the QTA team aware for any commitments that they may have during this period. If unavailability is not communicated in advance, there is a chance that the nominee will not be able to progress as a finalist.
Round 1 telephone interviews : 22 April to 3 May 2024
Round 2 telephone interviews : 2 to 9 August 2024
Please note you will not be require for all dates listed above. You will be scheduled on one of these days. These dates may alter slightly.

All finalists are **required** to attend the regional (July), state (September) and national (late November) finalist preparation, finalist week and awards presentation ceremonies, if applicable, it is **mandatory** for you to attend the regional and state finals for the announcement of the winner. Winners of the Queensland Training Awards (excluding the categories: Community Training Initiative and Equity VET Student) will be nominated by Queensland for the Australian Training Awards (ATA). All nominations will be considered by national judging panels and finalists for each award category will be required to attend the ATA finalists week in any state the ATA nominate.
3. By applying, all applicants of the Queensland Training Awards agree that all non-confidential details from their nominations, photographs and recordings can be used online, in any broadcast and print media and in a range of publicity, social media and promotional materials by the Queensland Government and the Australian Training Awards.
